## Section 98c Updated Learning Loss Plan 2022-2023

This funding is part of the Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) II Fund and the Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund. The funds support goal 5 of Michigan's Top 10 Strategic Education Plan. Funds are to target accelerated instruction to address learning loss. This application will outline the requirements of 98c, address the purpose of the funds, and outline funding under this grant.

The disrupted learning over the past three years have created learning gaps for students. Our plan is designed to support teachers in professional learning and implement student programs to meet students' instructional needs. To that end, Ida Public Schools will commit all of the allocated 98c funds with the explicit intention to mitigate learning loss through the implementation of targeted intervention support and groups for students.

Metrics used to assess and evaluate the impact on learning loss will include:

- NWEA MAP Growth for Reading and Math, 3 times per year (K-4<sup>th</sup> Grade)
- NWEA MAP Growth for Reading and Math, 2 times per year (5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade)
- STAR Reading Benchmark, 3 times per year (K-4<sup>th</sup> Grade)
- Acadience Progress Monitoring for reading and math (K-4<sup>th</sup> grade)
- Pre and post assessments
- Locally developed assessments
- English and Math course pass/fail rate (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade)
- State summative assessment data (M-Step, PSAT, SAT)
