11th Grade Checklist

September

October

November

- Opt in to [College Board Opportunity Scholarships](#)**
- You can earn scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$2,000 by completing individual college planning steps. Complete all six steps and you'll be eligible for the \$40,000 scholarship.

December

- Start exploring your college interests**
- Explore colleges of interest and build and save a college list on [BigFuture](#)™ with at least six (6) schools. You must be logged in to BigFuture™ using your College Board account.

January-March

- Prepare for the SAT**
- Access your PSAT results
- Log in and practice for the SAT using Official [SAT Practice](#) on Khan Academy® for at least six (6) hours. Link your College Board and Khan Academy® accounts

April

- Take the SAT**
- Take the SAT on April 14th
- Reflect on the experience and decide if you plan to retake the SAT. Talk to your counselor about options.

May

- Reflect on SAT results**
- Review SAT results and reflect on how these impact your college plans.
- Sign up to retake the SAT if applicable
- Continue exploring college interests**
